

SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES :

Directorate of Social Welfare provides Pre matric and post matric scholarship to Scheduled Caste (SC), Other Backward Classes(OBC), Physically Challenged Persons(PCP), Economically Backward Classes(EBC) and De notified Tribes(DNT) categories. The details of the scheme are as under:

a. For Scheduled Caste (SC) Category:

Pre-Matric Scholarship	Pre-Matric scholarship is provided to SC students from 1 st to 10 th class. There is no income bar of parents for pre-matric scholarship. The rates of scholarship are given in table 1.
Post-Matric Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme wherein SC students are provided financial assistance for pursuing Post Matriculation courses through recognized Institutions. Viz, 11th / 12th / Degree courses/ Technical courses, Professional Course etc.• The students of the higher secondary class, colleges, universities and professional colleges within the State as well as Outside the State are covered under the scheme and paid scholarship.• The parental income from all sources should not exceed Rs.2.5 lacs per annum.• Under this scheme non refundable fee and maintenance allowance is being provided to the students studying at the Post Matric Level in recognized Govt and Private Institutions.• The student should not be in receipt of any other scholarship under any other institution/course/category.• The rates of scholarship are given in table 2.
Special Coaching to SC students	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Under this scheme, all the students studying from class 9th to 12th belonging to SC category are being provided special coaching in their schools itself in three subjects viz English, Mathematics, Science for the period of three months especially during the last three months of the academic year i.e Dec-Feb.• The funds are paid to the teachers engaged for coaching @ Rs 300/= per subject per month for three months.
Re-imburement of	The fee of board examination is reimbursed to students reading in 10 th class. There is no income bar of parents under this scheme

Stipend to ITI students	The trainees are provided stipend at following rates:- Rs 100/- per month whose parental income is Rs 500/- per month. Rs 75/- per month whose parental income is Rs 750/- per month. Rs 50/- per month whose parental income is Rs 1000/- per month.
Book Bank Scheme	To establish book bank in Universities and Professional College for SC students. Sets of expensive books and Almirahs are provided for SC students studying in the professional colleges and university. Sanctioning authority is Director Social Welfare.

b. For Other Backward Classes (OBC) Category:

Pre-Matric Scholarship	Pre-Matric scholarship is provided to OBC students from 1 st to 10 th class. The parental income of the students should not exceed Rs 44,500/- P.A. to avail the scholarship under this category. The rates of scholarship are given in table 1.
Post-Matric Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme wherein OBC students are provided financial assistance for pursuing Post Matriculation courses through recognized Institutions. Viz, 11th / 12th / Degree courses/Technical courses, Professional Course etc. • The students of the higher secondary classes, colleges, universities and professional colleges within the State as well as Outside the State are covered under the scheme • Under this scheme all non refundable fee and maintenance allowance is being provided to the students at the Post Matric Level in recognized Govt and Private Institutions • The parental income from all sources should not exceed Rs. 1.00 lacs Per Annum. • The student should not be in receipt of any other scholarship under any other institution/course/category. • The rates of scholarship are given in table 2.

Re-imbursement of exam fees	The fee of board examination is reimbursed to students reading in 10 th class. For OBC students, monthly income should not exceed Rs. 44, 500/-per annum.
Stipend to ITI students	The OBC trainees are provided stipend at following rates:- Rs 100/- per month whose parental income is Rs 500/- per month. Rs 75/- per month whose parental income is Rs 750/- per month. Rs 50/- per month whose parental income is Rs 1000/- per month.

c. For Physically Challenged Persons (PCP) Category:

Pre-Matric Scholarship	Pre-Matric scholarship is provided to Physically Challenged Persons (PCP) students from 1 st to 10 th class.. The parental income of the students should not exceed Rs 44,500/- P.M. to avail the scholarship
Post-Matric Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is a State Sponsored Scheme wherein PHC students provided financial assistance for pursuing Post Matriculation courses through recognized Institutions. Viz, 11th / 12th / Degree courses/ Technical courses, Professional Course etc. • The students of the higher secondary classes, colleges, universities and professional colleges within the State as well as Outside the State are covered under the scheme • The parental income from all sources should not exceed Rs. 1.00 lacs Per Annum. • Under this scheme all non refundable fee and maintenance allowance is being provided to the students at the Post Matric Level in recognized Govt and Private Institutions • The student should not be in receipt of any other scholarship under any other institution/course/category. • The rates of scholarship are given in table 2.

d. For Economically Backward Classes(EBC) Category:

Post-Matric Scholarship	<p>Dr.Ambedkar postmatric scholarship for economically backward classes (EBC) students has been introduced by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the economically backward Students belonging to General Category of J&K State, studying at post matriculation or post secondary stage to enable them to complete their education ,other than Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe and Other Backward Classes.The parental income from all sources should not exceed Rs. 1.00 lacs Per Annum.The value of scholarship includes primarily Maintenance Allowance, reimbursement of compulsory non-refundable fees.</p> <p>The rates of scholarship are given in table 2.</p>

e. For Denotified Tribes(DNT) Category:

Post-Matric Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is a centrally sponsored scheme whereby the students belonging to Denotified , Nomadic and Semi Nomadic Tribes , who are not covered under SC/ST/OBC category , are provided financial assistance for pursuing Post Matriculation courses through recognized Institutions. Viz, 11th / 12th / Degree courses/ Technical courses, Professional Course etc.The three tribes of J&k covered under the scheme are Pohul, Sangtrash and Chaupan.• The students of the higher secondary classes, colleges, universities and professional colleges within the State as well as Outside the State are covered under the scheme• The parental income from all sources should not exceed Rs. 2.00 lacs Per Annum.• Under this scheme all non refundable fee and maintenance allowance is being provided to the students at the Post Matric Level in recognized Govt and Private Institutions• The student should not be in receipt of any other scholarship under any other institution/course/category.• The rates of scholarship are given in table 2.
